Trauma is a significant health problem across the lifespan, ranking in the top ten causes of death and projected to rank as the 4th leading cause of disability and it continues to impact the health care system significantly. Injured patients present a wide range of complex problems. Early identification is the key to recovery. The traumatic injury to be treated quickly and efficiently. Trauma nurses are the first healthcare professionals to assist and stabilize the condition of a patient as quickly as possible.
