The pandemic has profoundly changed the landscape of clinical nursing research and the profile of research nurses in hospitals and health services. However, nurses are leading in ways that are really quite similar to their usual work, but during a crisis, visibility and awareness of that work has been higher.

Nursing research has a tremendous influence on current and future professional nursing practice, thus rendering it an essential component of the educational process. It is a growing field in which nursing fraternity within the profession can contribute a variety of skills and experiences to the science of nursing care.
