Today, out of every 100 patients in acute-care hospitals, seven patients in high-income countries and 15 patients in low- and middle-income countries will acquire at least one health care-associated infection (HAI) during their hospital stay. On average, 1 in every 10 affected patients will die from their HAI.

According to the World Health Organization, HAIs account for 2 million cases and about 80,000 deaths a year. In India 1 in 4 are at risk of developing hospital acquired infections.

For the maintenance of strict infection control practices and ensuring adherence to norms, adequate training is essential. A periodic re-enforcement of practices, exploring the hurdles and solving the challenges with the help of planned training may be the key to ensure effective preventive practices.
